We are looking forward to getting to know you all and value all of your support as parents and carers. Please don't hesitate to contact your child's class teachers if you have any questions.



Maths


Number: Place Value

During this unit we will be exploring the place value of numbers, thinking carefully about what each digit represents as well as ordering and comparing numbers to 1000.

Number: Addition and subtraction

We will be adding and subtracting numbers with up to 3-digits, exploring mental methods as well as formal written methods. We will also be exploring exchanging numbers.

This term we will have a history focus! We will be identifying where this time in history fits within our historical timeline and how events can be placed in chronological order. We will be learning about what life was like during these times and exploring homes in the Stone Age. We will also be


Sikhism

Being Me in My World



Home Learning

- Spellings Spelling home learning continues to be set each week on EdShed. In order to complete their spelling home learning and to practice for their spelling test each Friday, we ask that the children complete a minimum of 4 games each week.
- Reading To encourage reading for pleasure and to support their progress, we ask that the children read as regularly as possible, ideally daily. Please ensure your child records every time they read in their reading record and that an adult signs it off. Reading records continue to be check on a regular basis in class.
- Maths Each week there will be a battle set on Times Table Rockstars for the children to access. It is really vital that children are learning their times tables.
- Education City- Will be used to support English/Maths.
